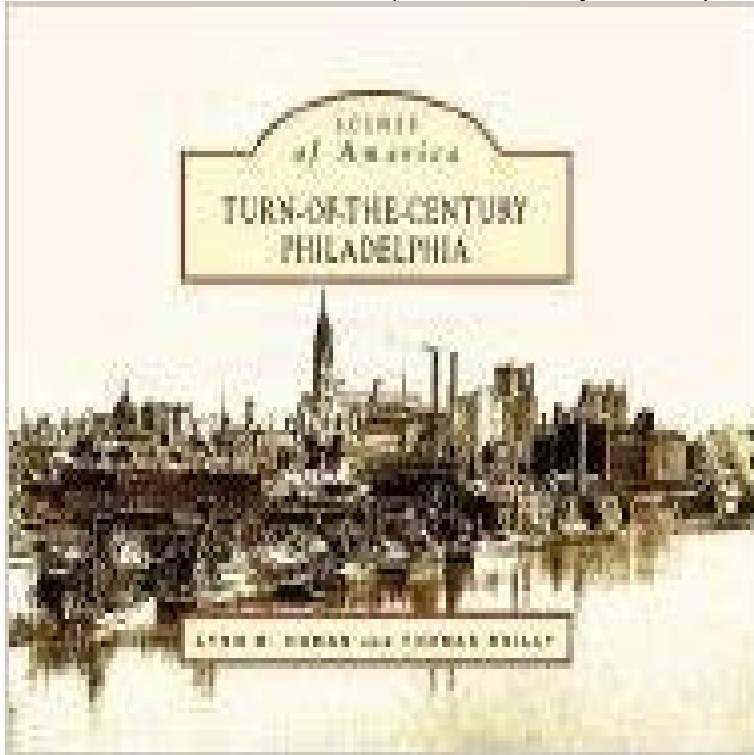


## Turn-of-the-Century Philadelphia (PA) (Scenes of America)
