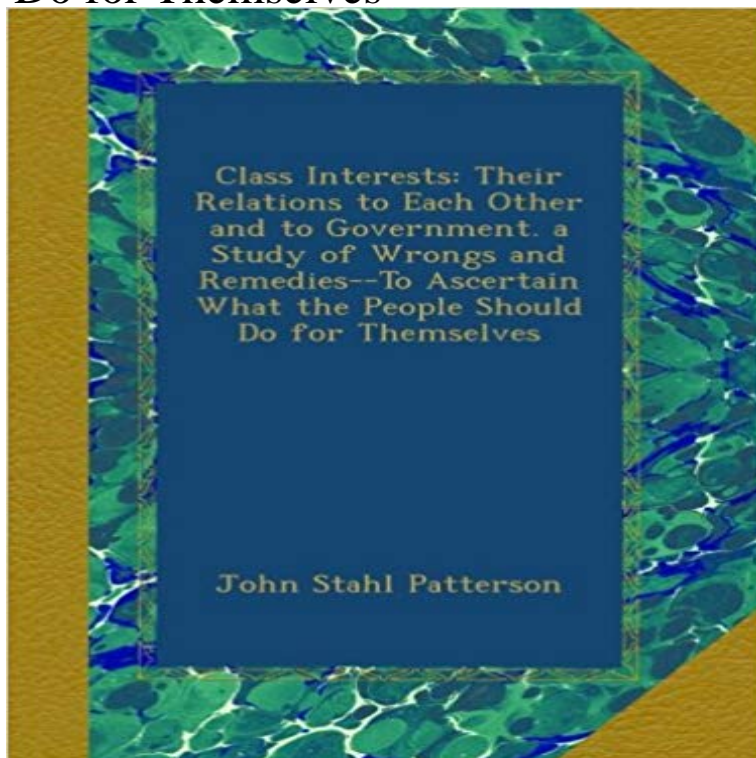


Class Interests: Their Relations to Each Other and to Government. a Study of Wrongs and Remedies--To Ascertain What the People Should Do for Themselves
