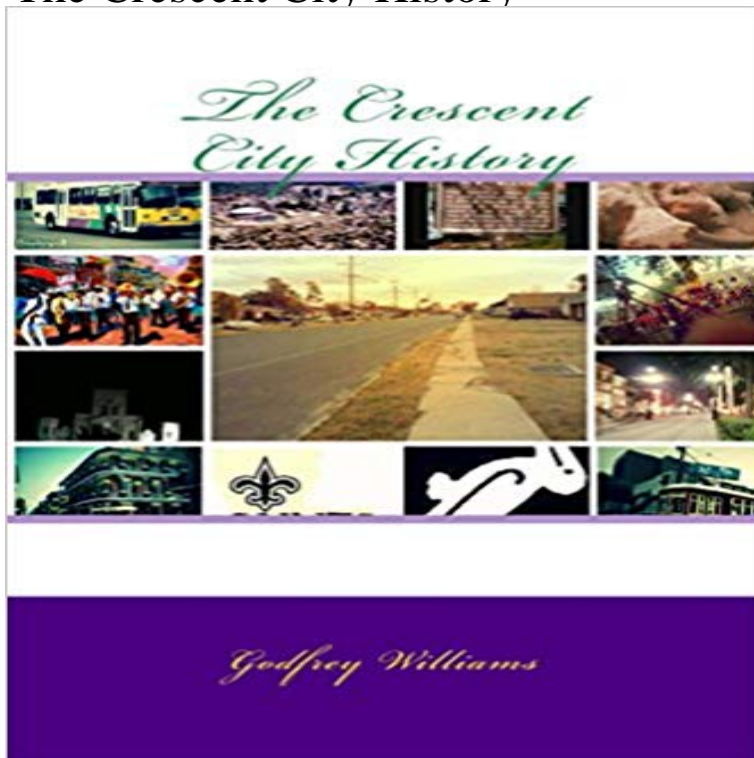


# The Crescent City History
