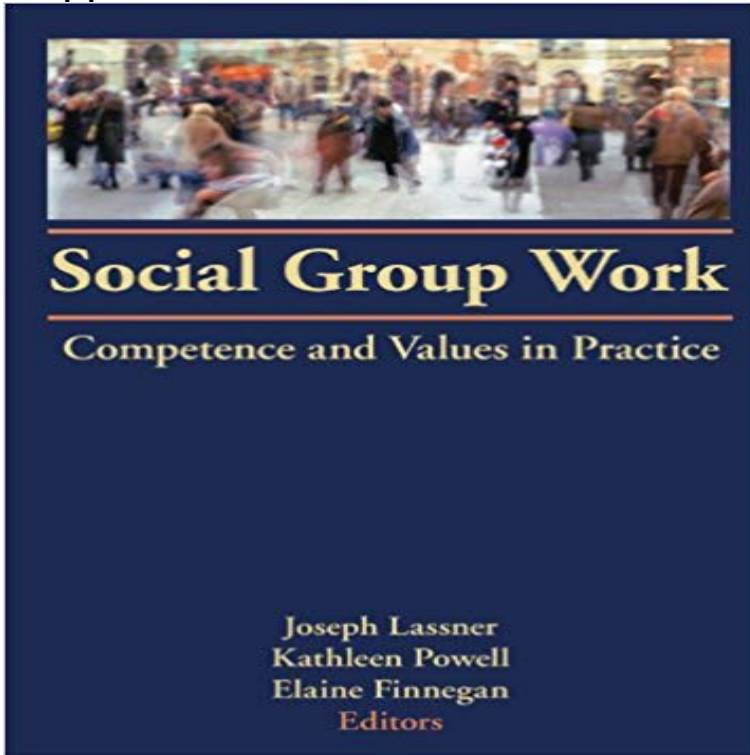


Social Group Work: Competence and Values in Practice (Monographic Supplement 2 to the Journal Social Work With Groups)
