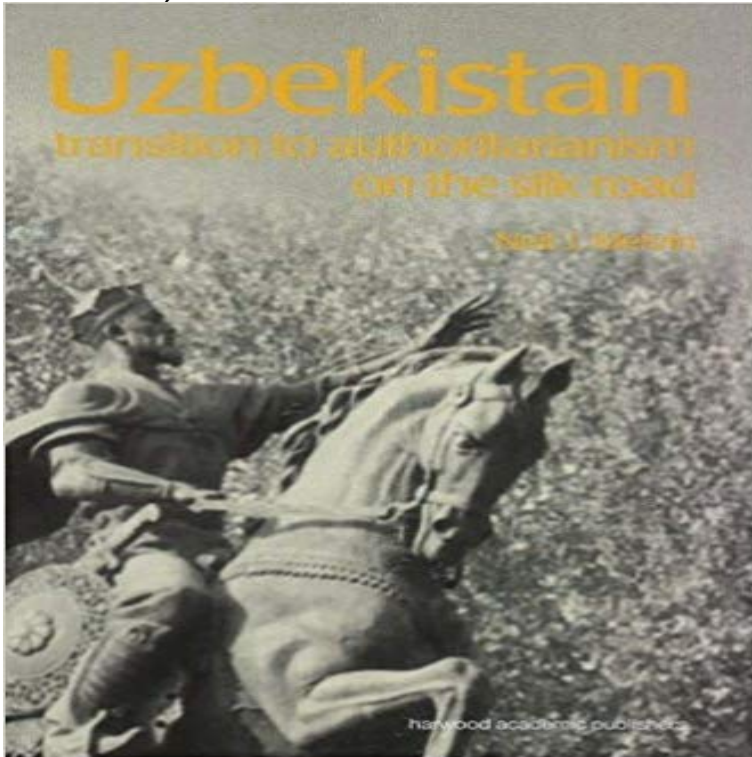


Uzbekistan: Transition to Authoritarianism (Postcommunist States and Nations)
